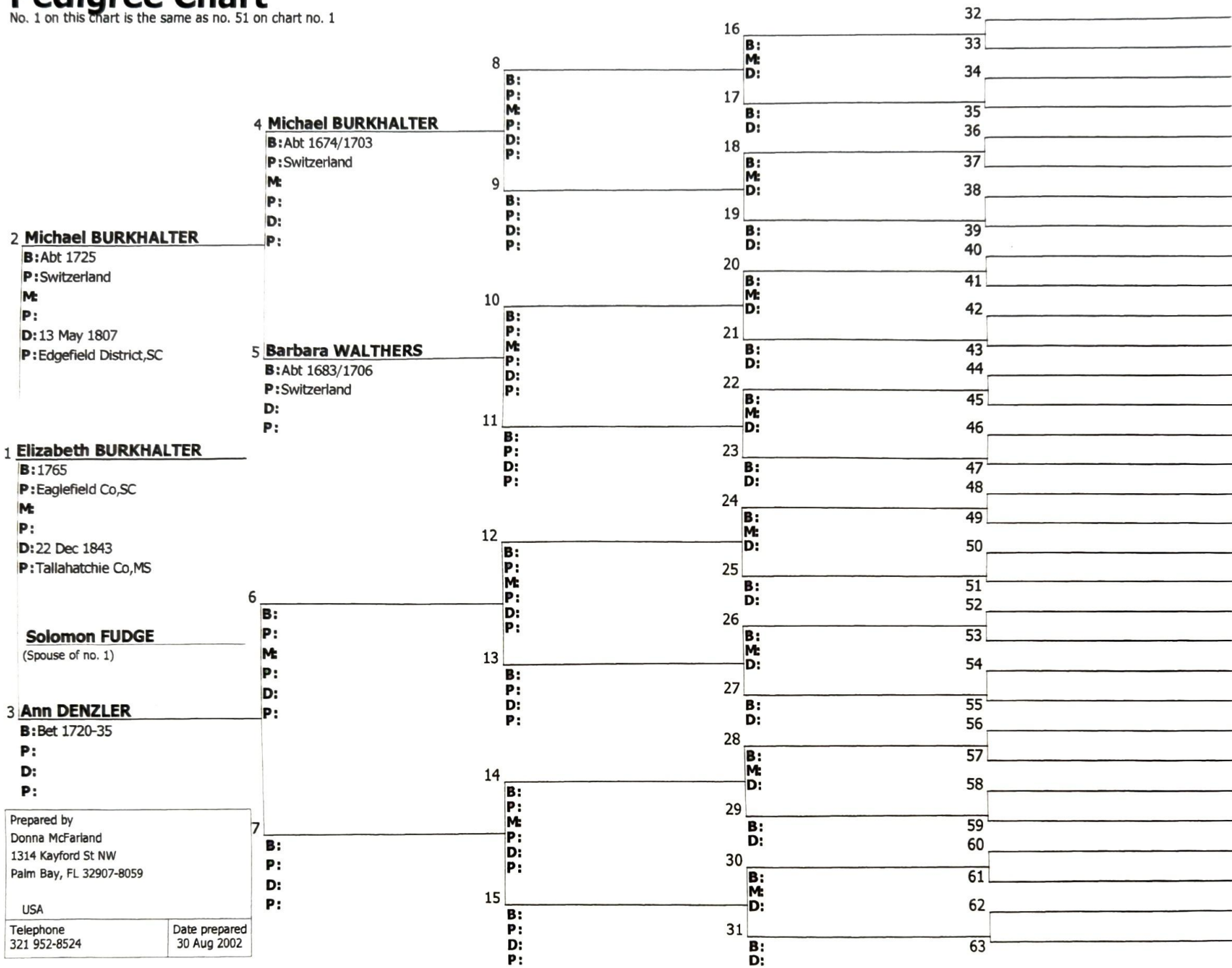

LIFE OF DR. OSCAR F. MCNABB

Oscar F. McNabb was born July 11, 1873 in Big Springs Meigs County, Tennessee, to Dr. Nathaniel Pinkney McNabb and Matilda Soloman McNabb. He was educated at Beta Academy in Meigs County. He graduated from the Medical Department of Grant University of Chattanooga in the 1897 Class with honors. The school later became the University of Chattanooga. He received his medical examination on April 4, 1900. He started practicing medicine in Whitwell, Tennessee for the Tennessee Coal and Iron Company in a hospital with Dr. Walter Nichols giving anesthesia for Dr. Nichols' surgery. He doctored the coal miners and their families. He also attended to the people of Cumberland Mountain. His speciality was delivering babies, and he delivered a great number for the community. He rode a yellow horse named Charlie who often brought him home at night when he was lost on the mountain. One night in the dark Charlie stopped dead still and would not budge. The doctor got off to see what was wrong and saw the horse was on the edge of a cliff. He turned the horse around and said, "Charlie, take me home."

Having been a horse and buggy doctor he purchased a T-Model Ford when they came on the market. The salesman had given him verbal instructions on how to drive his new car. After getting it home, he practiced driving in the backyard thinking he knew all about it. He soon found out he needed more lessons as he had to run into a tree to stop it. No damage was done to either car or driver. His eldest son, John Tate, took over the job of

chauffeuring his dad.

Dr. McNabb was a very kind and sentimental person who was very generous. Several times he would bring people home with him who were homeless. On cold nights, Mrs. McNabb would wrap his head in a scarf to keep his ears from freezing--as he went out all hours of the night in severe weather. He was witty--often telling jokes. He had a speech defect that amused people. It did not hamper his communication with others. He didn't have any hobbies, and he considered ballgames a waste of time and energy. He liked cattle raising and farming on his farm in Victoria. He was a member of the Whitwell Methodist Church, a Mason, Odd Fellows, Modern Woodmen of the World, and Red Men.

He was married to Thursa Elizabeth Easterly on November 25, 1906 in Whitwell at the home of the bride's sister, Mrs. Arenda Dykes (Elijah) with family and a few friends present. "Miss Lizzie" was born May 12, 1876 at Sunnyside, Tennessee. She died May 12, 1960 and is buried at Whitwell Memorial Cemetery.

Oscar and Elizabeth had five children. John Tate was born on September 13, 1907 and died April 9, 1946. He was a medical doctor. He married Corine Combs in Trenton, Tennessee. They had a son, Jimmy Tate. Katherine was born August 10, 1909. She married Cecil E. Hudson in Whitwell. They lived in Mobile, Alabama where their children, Lynda Jean, Robert Hugh, and Mary Katherine, were born. Katherine was a school teacher. Mary Seagle was born September 28, 1911. She married Robert S. Clemmer in Greeneville, Tennessee. They had Elizabeth Ann and Alice Haws in Pikeville, Tennessee. Mary Seagle was a Registered nurse.

Henry Nathaniel was born June 10, 1914 and died January 15, 1953. His burial took place in Birmingham, Alabama on February 16, 1953. By his first wife, Arzell Phillips, Joy Marie was born in Jasper, Tennessee. By his second wife, Edith Thompson, Hershel Drew and Billy Frank were born. They lived in Birmingham, Alabama. Nathan served in the Merchant Marines. Hershel Pope was born on September 12, 1916 and died May 8, 1985 in Arlington, Texas. He was married to Martha Jane Layne in Dunlap, Tennessee. They had one child, Ella Jane. They lived in Dunlap, Tennessee. Hershel served in the U. S. Army during World War II.

Dr. McNabb died April 12, 1923 in the hospital at Fairfield, Alabama. This was the regional hospital for the Coal Company. Dr. McNabb died as a result of a gunshot wound. His burial was at the Oak Grove Cemetary near his farm in Victoria, Tennessee. Later, he was moved to the Whitwell Memorial Cemetary at Whitwell, Tennessee. He left a wife with five small children to raise. With God's help, she reared them bravely and courageously until they were all grown.

Conrad Denzler was the fourth child of his parents, but the first to survive infancy. He grew up in the parish of Illnau near Zurich. The people in this area of Switzerland spoke German, so Denzler is often mistaken for a German. In 1723 at age 20, he married a local girl, Anna Wetzstein. They had 7 children whose christening records are found at the parish church. Two children died young before 1737.

The Denzlers joined the Swiss migration to colonial Georgia. They traveled with Anna's brother Hans Wetzstein and his family, leaving Illnau down the Limmat River to the Rhine and on to Rotterdam. In England, they would have stopped to be approved by the Trustees of the colony of Georgia. They would have taken an oath similar to one included in Faust: "We Subscribers Natives and late Inhabitants of the Canton of Bern in Switzerland and places adjacent, having transported ourselves and families into the Province of Pennsylvania a Colony subject to the laws[?] of Great Britain in hopes and expectation of finding a Retreat and peaceable settlement therein, Do Solemnly promise and ingage that we will be faithful and bear true Allegiance to his Present Majesty King George the Second and his Successors Kings of Great Britain, and will be faithfull to the Proprietor of this Province, and that we will demean ourselves peaceably to all his said Majesties Subjects, and strictly observe and conform to the Laws of England and of this Province to the utmost of our Power and best of our understanding." (Faust, plate 14)

The Denzlers arrived in Savannah GA on the ship "Three Sisters" on Dec 21 1737 in what is called "The Second Palatine Transport." The following description comes from George Jones' book Detailed Reports on the

Salzburger Emigrants Who Settled in America, "This, the largest of the German transports, was recruited in the summer of 1737, a time when many Germans were clamoring for passage to the Island of Pennsylvania, or willing to go to Georgia in the West Indies. Since the ship's manifest still exists, the number of passengers is quite reliable, even if some names have been distorted beyond recognition. Unlike the Salzburgers, many of these Palatines do not appear in German documents, and therefore the correct forms of their names cannot be ascertained. The party had been badly treated by the Hopes of Rotterdam, notorious dealers in human cargoes, who had broken all promises and packed them in the Three Sisters like sardines. As a result, when they went ashore in Cowes in southern England, they refused to go back aboard until certain conditions were rectified. The Trustees, to whom they were indentured, sent an agent to Cowes to look into their plight; and after certain reforms were made or promised, they went back aboard, sullen and mutinous. Their captain, Hewitt (first name not recorded), brought them on Dec 21 [1737] to Tybee Island at the mouth of the Savannah River, where they had to remain ten more days for want of a pilot.

"Although lumped together as "Palatines," it appears that a good percentage of these passengers were Wurttembergers. The birth dates on the following list are deduced from the ages given by the passengers, who may sometimes have suppressed a few years in the belief that only young people had a good chance to be indentured."

The list of passengers of "Indentured Servants who Arrived in Georgia on the Three Sisters, Capt. Hewitt, on 21 Dec 1737" includes Conrad Denzler, his wife Anna (incorrectly identified as Hanna Dorothea), and children Anna, son Heinrich (Henry), daughter Regula, son Caspar, and son Hans Jacob (John Jacob). Conrad and his family could not pay for their passage to the new world, so they indentured themselves. Their term of service was probably 5 years because on December 24 1742, Densler qualified for a lot of land: "The Dutch [German] servants lately out of their time attending the Board for the better confirmation of those lots that they drew yesterday, and Mr. Avery being sent for to shew us the plan of those lands, which he had run out for their use, wherein it appear'd that there were 30 lots laid down for the like number of families, the following list of 26 of those entitled to the possession thereof was enter'd on the plan." (CR 6) Conrad was granted 41 acres in Vernonburg. Vernonburg was located a few miles south of Savannah and can be found on modern maps.

In May 1745, Michael Burkhalter applied to the colony Trustees for his wife Anna to receive an allowance for her servitude. The Trustees denied the application, stating that the Denzler family had received their

allowance. (CR 6) This may imply that Conrad had already died.

Conrad died prior to March 1750 because at that time, "Widow Denzler of Vernonburg" was recommended by Rev. Zouberbuhler "as an object of compassion, being left in a weakly condition with several children." She was granted 10 shillings per month. (CR 6)

Of their 7 children, 2 died young in Switzerland. Of the 5 who arrived in Georgia, three probably died young. There is no further mention of Regula, Casper, or Hans Jacob. Only Anna and Henry matured to adulthood, married, and raised families. The Denzler descendents of SC descend from son Henry and spell the name as Densler while Anna's descendents came through the Burkholders.

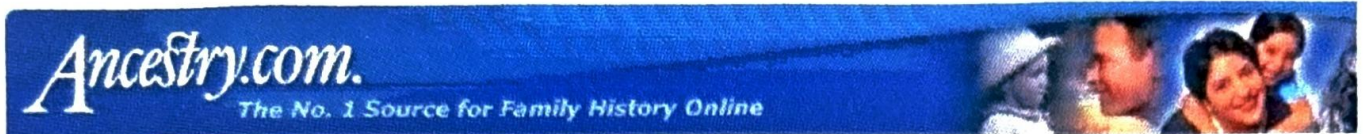

He lived in North Carolina for some time and was an active member of the patriotic organization known as the Regulators in that state. History records that his son, Jacob Fudge Jr. died in Crawford County, GA, where he received a Revolutionary pension. road from North Augusta, South Carolina, toward Edgefield, South Carolina, the bank of the property now owned by the Field's family, is walled with stones taken from the old chimney of the Jacob Fudge, Sr., house.

Will of Jacob Fudge, Senior

In the name of God Amen, I jacob Fudge Senior of South Carolina and Edgefield County being weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament, that is to say, principally and first of all, -- I gave and recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial, at the discretion of my executors, nothing doubting, but at the general resurrection, I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give and demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form.

Imprinis.

I gave and bequeath to my loving wife Margaret Fudge during her natural life or widowhood the use of all my movable estate and negroes, except my smiths shop and smith tools, then to be disposed of after her decease, as shall be here after mentioned, an likewise, she my said wife, Margaret Fudge is to live at the plantation and mills whereon I now live during her life time or widowhood.

Item I gave and bequeath to my beloved son John Fudge three hundred acres of land be the same more or less, being part of a six hundred and forty acre surveyed by Jacob Fudge Junr, the said three hundred acres to be bounded on the East Side by the main fork of Little Horse Creek and down said creek to the mouth of the branch called Nappers Branch, then up said branch to where said Nappers old cabbin is thence along the old line to the aforesaid main fork of Little Horse Creek, he, the said John Fudge granting his brothers Jacob Fudge and William Fudge the liberty of building mills on said Little Creek without any interruption of or by him the said John Fudge and the said three hundred acres of land to be for him the said John Fudge and his heirs forever.

Item I gave and bequeath to my loving sons Jacob Fudge and William Fudge two thousand acres of land on Little Horse Creek, be the same more or less with the saw mill thereon. The said Jacob Fudge is not to have a part or benefit of the said mill above mentioned until his brother Richard Fudge arrives to the age of twenty one years of age, then the said Jacob Fudge and William Fudge to be joint owners in and to the said saw mill and land above mentioned. The said William Fudge a dying and

leaving no lawful heir to his body then his part of said mill and land to be divided amongst the rest of his brothers and sisters then living, and I like wise gave and bequeath to my son William Fudge five hundred acres of land, part of two thousand three hundred and sixty five acres, including the head of Franklins Branch joining the survey of three hundred and twenty seven acres.

Item I gave and bequeath to my loving sons Soloman Fudge and Richard Fudge the plantation where I formerly lived, that goes by the name of Journegans ole place and fifth six acres that goes by the name of Clausures Survey and likewise the three hundred and twenty seven acres that joins Journegans ole place, and likewise Soloman Fudge, William Fudge and Richard Fudge is jointly to assist in building of a grist mill on said lands, and likewise the said Soloman Fudge and Richard Fudge is to be joint owners in and to the said lands and mill, and likewise the above mentioned William Fudge is with the assistance of Richard Fudge and Jacob Fudge Junr, that is to say; all the lumber and planks sufficient to build an house shed and peibzer thirty two feet long and twenty four feet wide, for the use of said Richard Fudge, and likewise it is my will and desire that the grist mill stones mill irons and all that belongs to the grist mill where I now live, be removed to the above mentioned Soloman Fudge and Richard Fudge lands. It likewise is my will and desire that if any of the above mentioned Soloman Fudge or Richard Fudge should die having no lawful heir of their body, the surviving one of the two to have the above mentioned lands and mill mentioned.

Item It is likewise my will and desire that my son, Jacob Fudge is likewise to have one hundred acres of land on the Water of Chavoufes Creek, surveyed by Henry Napper now in my possession.

Item It is likewise my will and desire that my son William Fudge is to have my smiths tools, he allowing the rest of his brothers the liberty of doing their own work with said tools in the shop.

Item I gave and bequeath to my loving daughter Elizabeth Addams the fourth part of my movable estate after her mothers decease, to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I gave and bequeath to my loving daughter Mary Clarklers children that she bears to John Clarkler the fourth part of my movable estate after my wife's Margaret Fudges decease to be equally divided amongst them the said Mary Calrklers children.

Item I gave and bequeath unto my son-in-law, John Clarkler one tract of land containing two hundred and fifty acres lying on Benjamin Franklin Branch. Branch bounded by William Fudge, Benjamin Cooks and John Carters lands to him and his heirs forever.

I gave and bequeath unto my daughter Suffiah Cook five pound sterling, to be paid of my movable estate.

It is likewise my will and desire that my son William Fudge does take and raise Clothe and school my daughter Suffiahs two children that she

bore to William Jones and keep them up until they arrive to the age of twenty one, then the said children of my daughter Suffiah is to have the fourth part of my movable estate deducting the five pounds out of it which I have already willed and bequeathed to their mother Suffiah Cook.

Item I like will give and bequeath unto my son William Fudge one negro fellow named Bob in retaliation for his trouble and expense of raising, schooling and clothing the above mentioned two children of my daughter Suffiahs to be to him as his proper right, after his mothers decease to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I gave and bequeath unto my loving daughter Margret Fudge one negro fellow named Tom to her and her heirs for ever and likewise, the fourth part of my movable estate, after her mother's decease.

Lastly, I do constitute to this my last will and testament, my well belovd sons John Fudge and William Fudge to be my executors to my last Will and Testament, and I do hereby also revoke and disannul all other wills, bequeaths and testaments by me heretofore and before made, and also I do disanul all other executors by me herfore appointed.

Signed, sealed, published and declared in the presence of us who in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witnesses to the same, this eight day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine.

The old cemetery where Jacob Fudge is buried is located on a high hill on the east side of Little Horse Creek. On a bluff at the foot of this hill and near the old mill site on the creek was his home, a commodious two-story structure. Only a pile of rock shows where it stood.

There is now a pleasure resort known as "Antique Lake" at the old site, and a modern cottage stands near the old home site. Jacob Fudge, b. ca. 1723 is probably the Jacob Fuge who married Margaret, dau. of Richard Gregory (Berks Co., PA Will Book I, p. 173), and Jacob Fudge may be the son of the Jacob Fuge who has been reported as a known head of a household in the Oley Valley, Berks Co.,

PA in 1727 (OLEY VALLEY HERITAGE, Appendix 7, P. 177). Jacob Fudge, b. ca. 1723, may be the Jacob Fotch who, with his wife Anna Margaretha, had their son Johann Jacob (born 5 Jan 1758) baptized at the Oley Hill Church, Berks Co., PA on 11 Jun 1758, and their daughter Sabina (born 1 July 1763) baptized in the same church 30 Oct 1763. (see BERKS COUNTY CHURCH RECORDS of the 18th CENTURY compiled by F. Edward Wright, vol. 2, pp. 6 and 15). Richard Gregory resided on the road to Huff's Church northwest of Harlem, Hereford Twp., Berks Co. as early as 1719. His wife, Margaretha, (nee Bixby ?) who was named in his will, may be a second wife. These documents may account for Jacob Fudge's years in Pennsylvania prior to his migration to the Carolinas.

JACOB FUDGE received a land warrant in 1750 for 123 acres on Tract #168 situated in Brunswick Twp., Berks Co. (today Schuylkill Co.) PA, and another land warrant in 1751 for 61 acres on Tract #133 located in Brunswick Twp., Berks Co., PA also.

On 30 Dec 1752 JACOB FUDGE is taxed in Brunswick Twp., Berks Co. (today Schuylkill Co.) along with his brothers-in-law John Jones and George Mock.

In 1753 JACOB FUCHS is taxed in Brunswick Twp. along with his brothers-in-law John Jones and George Mock.

In 1754 JACOB FUCHS is taxed again in Brunswick Twp. along with his brothers-in-law John Jones and George Mock.

The next extant tax list for Brunswick Twp. is in 1769. None of the above three men appear on this tax list. This suggests to me that the brothers-in-law and the Gregory wives, daughters of Richard Gregory (died 1765) of Harlem, Hereford Twp., Berks Co., PA had migrated to the Carolinas by this time, possibly after the death of Richard Gregory in 1765. More research must be conducted in the land records of Berks county to determine the disposition of the lands they received, etc.

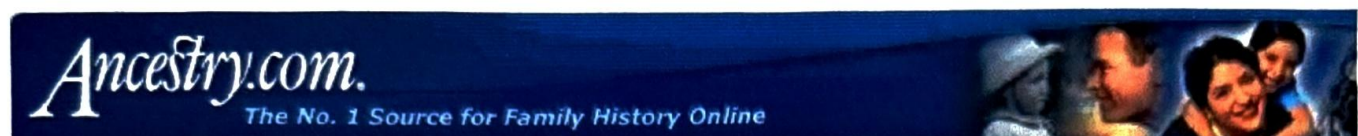

The public has access to certain military service information without the veteran's authorization (or that of the next-of-kin of deceased veterans). Examples of information which may be available from Official Military Personnel Files without an unwarranted invasion of privacy include:

Name
Service Number
Rank
Dates of Service
Awards and decorations
Place of entrance and separation **If the veteran is deceased:**
Place of birth
Date and geographical location of death
Place of burial

An individual's complete service record is available to the former service member or, if deceased, to his/her next of kin (parents, spouse, or children). Limited information (such as dates of service, awards, and training) is available to anyone. Not available to the general public is information which would invade an individual's privacy; for example, medical records, Social Security number, or present address.
